	Inspection and Acceptance The detailed inspection and acceptance of the delivered and installed specialized shooting range equipment shall be conducted in accordance with the standard acceptance procedures applicable to procured goods. All items shall be new, unused, and accompanied by the relevant certificates of conformity, quality certificates, and any other required documentation. For the ballistic protection components to be installed within the shooting range, including ballistic wall coverings, bullet traps, overhead baffles, bulletproof windows, ballistic doors, and any other components intended to provide ballistic protection, the Contractor shall provide ballistic test reports or certificates issued by an internationally recognized testing laboratory accredited in accordance with ISO/IEC 17025. These reports or certificates shall demonstrate that

	the performance characteristics of the supplied components meet or exceed the minimum requirements specified in the technical specifications. All delivered items and installed integrated systems, including the shooting range command and control equipment and related software, shall undergo functional testing to verify compliance with the intended design and operational requirements. Software testing shall also include verification of backup and restore functionality. The successful Contractor shall develop and submit detailed inspection, testing, and commissioning procedures describing the methodology for verifying compliance with the technical specifications. Upon completion of the activities, the Contractor shall provide the corresponding inspection records, test reports, and commissioning documentation demonstrating the proper functionality and performance of the supplied equipment and systems. The Contractor shall also provide a complete documentation package in English and/or Romanian, including user manuals, certificates, spare parts lists, maintenance plans, and any other relevant technical documentation. Inspection and preliminary functional testing shall be completed prior to the training and commissioning activities described under the Training and Commissioning section below.
